FATAL TRAFFIC COLLISION INVOLVING MOTORCYCLIST

October 22, 2020

Burbank, California – A motorcyclist from Rancho Cucamonga has died following an early morning collision with a tow truck.

On October 21, 2020, at about 5:45 a.m., Burbank Police and Paramedics responded to the area of Riverside Drive and Bob Hope Drive after receiving a report of a traffic collision involving a motorcycle. When police officers and paramedics arrived, they located a motorcyclist underneath a tow truck who was unresponsive. The man had sustained serious injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The driver of the tow truck remained at the scene and was interviewed by traffic investigators.

The motorcyclist has been identified as Arnie Cervantes, a 38-year-old resident of Rancho Cucamonga.

This collision remains under the investigation of Burbank Police Department Traffic Detectives. Anyone who may have witnessed the collision is asked to contact the Burbank Police Traffic Bureau, at (818) 238-3100.
