Drug Take Back Event Nets Over 350 Pounds

This year's second prescription Drug Take Back event was held on Saturday, October 27, providing an opportunity for people to drop-off unused, unwanted, or expired medications on a "no questions asked" basis. This biannual event is hosted by the Drug Enforcement Administration and is aimed to provide a safe method of disposal for medications, while reducing the likelihood of misuse. This most recent event collected over 350 pounds of medication!
